Precautions for the weekend of 19-20 December 2020

This letter follows my letter dated 16th December 2020. It provides important information in relation to the developing news of COVID-19 cases in Sydney. We are excluding anyone who has been in an area of increased testing for COVID-19 in the previous 14 days. At the time of writing this includes the Penrith and Northern Beaches local government areas.

In addition to excluding staff and visitors who have been in the areas noted above, we are temporarily reintroducing a 2-visitor per resident limit this weekend. We are limiting the total number of visitors at any time to 15 per site. Visitors with approved visitor status are not subject to this limit and continue to have priority access. If necessary, we will limit the length of visits to ensure equitable access for visitors.

No outings will be permitted this weekend unless prior approval has been granted.

Wearing a surgical mask at Harbison is mandatory for non-residents until further notice.

We encourage everyone to monitor case location alerts from NSW Health <https://www.health.nsw.gov.au/Infectious/covid-19/Pages/case-locations-and-alerts.aspx> and will update staff by Microsoft Teams.

We strongly recommend people reconsider plans to travel to Sydney this weekend. Staff who travel to Sydney may find themselves excluded from work on their return if they visit an area that becomes subject to an alert.

We will review these precautions on Monday 21 December 2020. I apologise for any inconvenience.
